Edward Greene is a senior finance professional with core competencies in Strategic Decision, Risk, and Change Management. He is currently the Director of Operational Risk Management for the Multifamily Division at Freddie Mac, a \$100 billion business unit. In this role he is responsible for assessing business unit exposure, identifying risks, evaluating their potential impact, and reviewing the strengths and weaknesses of the business unit's controls. Prior to assuming this position he held director level enterprise and credit risk management positions at Freddie Mac.
