AMERICAN JOBS FOR AMERICA'S HEROES



On Saturday, December 10, 2011 CASY-MSCCN Executive Director Stacy Bayton, along with Michigan Governor Rick Snyder, MI National Guard Commander Major General Vadnais, Center for America's Bob Dorigo Jones, and Nashville recording artist Matt Dime kicked off the "American Jobs for America's Heroes" National Guard Employment Program in Lansing, Michigan. The event was held

at the Lansing Center in Lansing, Michigan from 12:30-2:30 PM.

This event was the start of a national launch to increase employment opportunities for National Guard and Reserve Veterans with the alliance of two powerful programs, the National Guard Employment Network and the American Jobs for America's Heroes Campaign (AJAH). The AJAH initiative is powered by an alliance of the National Guard, the non-profit Center for America (CFA), and the non-profit Military Spouses Corporate Career Network (MSCCN) and Corporate America Supports You (CASY) to inspire thousands of small and mid-size companies to commit to register and post jobs through the National Guard Employment Network. The National Guard Employment Network is powered through a partnership between CASY, MSCCN, DirectEmployers Association, Kenexa, and the National Guard Bureau. Both partnerships are key in meeting the employment needs of our National Guard and Reserve forces and their families.
