Pat joined Sabreliner Corporation as executive advisor to the chairman in April of 2009. He assumed his current position in July of 2009.

Pat's responsibilities include all aspects of the day-to-day conduct of Sabreliner's business. Pat is also a member of the company's board of directors and he reports to the chairman.



Finneran recently retired from the Boeing Company after a distinguished 22 year career in various executive posts. Pat held various leadership positions including president of Boeing Support Systems, a \$7 billion business unit that provided a complete spectrum of defense services for warfighters. Pat also served as vice president of Program Management and Business Excellence and vice president of Operations & Supplier Management as well as St. Louis site manager, responsible for the day-to-day St. Louis operations.

Previous assignments included vice president and general manager of Naval Aircraft Programs, responsible for the F/A-18, AV-8, T-45, P-8A, CH-46, E-6A and V-22 programs. Prior to that assignment, he served as vice president and general manager for the F/A-18 programs. During the F/A-18 E/F development for which the program was awarded the Collier Trophy.

Finneran, who joined what was then McDonnell Douglas in 1987, had led every military aircraft program in St. Louis.

Finneran holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Notre Dame and a master's degree from East Carolina University. He is an honor graduate of the U.S. Marine Corps Basic School, U.S. Marine Corps Amphibious Warfare School, U.S. Air Force Command and Staff College, and a graduate of the National War College. In 2004 he was awarded the Navy League's prestigious Fleet Admiral Chester Nimitz Award for major contributions to America's Maritime Strength & National Security. He is also a recipient of the Distinguished Alumni Award of the Mendoza School of Business at the University of Notre Dame. In April 2009, Pat received an Honorary Doctorate from Notre Dame along with President Obama.

Finneran is the chairman of the Advisory Council for Graduate Studies and Research at the University of Notre Dame. He is also a member of the continuing education council in the Mendoza School of Business there. He is vice chairman of the Naval Aviation Museum Foundation, trustee of the Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation, Board Member of the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra and St. Louis Municipal Opera, a Director of the St. Louis Grand Center, Inc. and Fellow of the Royal Aeronautical Society.

Finneran was commissioned a Second Lieutenant on June 3, 1967 via the NROTC Program at Notre Dame and is a Vietnam combat veteran. He served in a variety of operational deployments and staff positions including a special assignment as the military aide to the Secretary of the Treasury, the Honorable Donald J. Regan, from November 1980 through the 1981 inauguration. He retired after 20 years of active duty in 1987 at the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. His military decorations include the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service medal with Gold Star, Air Medal, Navy Commendation medal with Gold Star and 'V' and a Navy Achievement medal.
