Admiral Mike Mullen**

On Saturday, August 23, Deb Kloeppe, President and CEO of the MSCCN, was invited to keynote address and personally participate in a prestigious and select group of military spouse leadership discussing the training, education, and job placement of our nation's veterans and military spouses in a global market.
